How to book my interview online

Step 1: Open online page in your internet browser:

www.schoolinterviews.com.au

Step 2: Click on the "Make a Booking" button. The school code is n9mbh

Step 3: Complete the booking form with your email address, your name and your child's name. A confirmation email will be sent to the email address you supply here.

Step 4: Click on your child's classroom teacher.

Step 5: Click on the day and time you would like your booking.

Step 6: You will now receive an email with confirmation of your appointments and what to do if you need to change them for any reason.

look at some of the other ratings:

What if my child is rated 'D'?

Your child is working towards (approaching) the standard expected at their year/grade level.

Talk to their teacher about what is happening to support your child at school and what you can do to help at home.

What if my child is rated 'E'?

Your child is finding learning difficult and is receiving a lot of help already. We know they are trying really hard.

Your child is working as part of the whole class, in small groups and sometimes one on one with an adult. Their program is designed to match their level of learning.

School Association – Update of Policies

Our School Association has reviewed and modified two of our policies as part of its annual work. The two policies are the Headlice and Uniform and Dress Code Policy. The changes include the following:

Head Lice Policy:

Return to school: Students may return to school following one application of a recommended product and once all eggs have been removed.

Uniform and Dress Code Policy:

Overall Appearance

Colouring of hair, tattoos, wearing make-up and coloured nail polish are discouraged as they are not appropriate to school uniform.

- For health and safety reasons: nails need to be kept short to a safe length,
- studs and sleepers are the only earrings allowed,
- facial piercings are not allowed and
- necklaces and bracelets are discouraged.
- * NB Footwear is to meet Occupational Health and Safety guidelines, i.e. must be covered footwear, not

sandals, thongs/slides, Ugg boots, high heels or slippers. If unacceptable footwear is worn, students may be excluded from some activities.

We thank parents for their support in implementing these changes.
