Dear Community Our Values

This week we are exploring the value of Courage which means showing resilience, taking risks, speaking up and persevering. Learning doesn't take place without courage. Acting with courage means:

- accepting challenges and embracing opportunities.
- thinking creatively and being brave.
- being prepared to stand up for what's important.
- not giving up.
- having difficult conversations (including when people's behaviour does not align with our values).
- being innovative and taking calculated risks in some situations.

Courage is not necessarily loud, but is sometimes quiet and thoughtful.

Take some time to talk with your children about times when they might use or have used the value of 'courage'.

National Assessment Program – Literacy and Numeracy (NAPLAN) Testing

Next week, students in Grades 3 and 5 will begin to complete the 2021 NAPLAN tests.

This will happen in a window from Tuesday 11th - Friday 14th May and then Tuesday 18th - Friday 21st May. Students in Grade 3 and 5 will complete the 2021 NAPLAN tests online. Please note that Grade 3 students will still do a handwritten writing test.

The best way you can help your child prepare for NAPLAN is to let them know that NAPLAN is just one part of their school program, and to urge them to simply do the best they can on the day. An individual student NAPLAN report will be issued by the school later this year. Parents can use this information to monitor how their child is progressing and to identify any areas of concern. Parents may also wish to use their child's results to discuss progress with teachers. More information is available at www.nap.edu.au. 
Sharing Assembly – 5/6 Dowde
