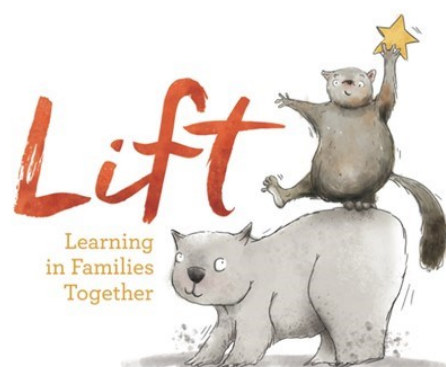
Regional Primary School Basketball Championships
