School Nurse

My name is Louise Hawkins, and I am Bridport Primary School's new School Health Nurse on Mondays. The role of the Primary School Health Nurse is to provide health education and health promotion to students and the school community. This includes health assessments for Kindergarten students and engaging all grades in lessons and group activities surrounding health and wellbeing. Some of these lessons and activities will include education on nutrition, personal

hygiene, oral care, sun safety, growth and development, positive mental health and mindfulness. Vision and hearing screens for all primary students are also available on request if there is a specific concern. Consent forms must be signed by a parent/guardian prior to all assessments, including Kindergarten health assessments.

All sessions are free of charge and all equipment is provided.


