Cross Country Carnival

Our Prep – Grade 6 Cross Country Carnival will be held next Wednesday, 25th May, starting at the Village Green, into the caravan park, down the beach and back to the Village Green.

Parents/spectators are most welcome to encourage the children in their races, however they are not to be near the students. For example, parents/spectators can watch the carnival by sitting on the hill of the Village Green. All adults need to remember to social distance as per COVID-19 guidelines.

Any help on the day will be greatly appreciated as extra people are needed on checkpoints to ensure the safety of the children. Please advise the school office if you can assist, remembering that helpers need an RWVP and must be double vaccinated.

Keeping Our Schools COVID Safe

A reminder that Close contacts who do not have symptoms and return a daily negative test no longer have to isolate. If staff or students have symptoms and have not had COVID-19 in the past 12 weeks, they must stay home and do a RAT. It is important to get tested for COVID-19 if any of the following symptoms occur, even mild, unless it has been less than 12 weeks since the person was released from isolation for COVID-19. The common symptoms of COVID-19 are: fever (or signs of fever, including chills or night sweats), runny nose, cough, sore or itchy throat, shortness of breath, loss of taste or smell. Other symptoms that can occur include gastrointestinal symptoms (nausea, diarrhoea, and vomiting) headache, muscle and joint pain, loss of appetite, fatigue.

If the RAT is positive, staff and students must stay home for seven days and isolate. They must report the positive RAT to Public Health - this is a requirement under Section 16 of the Public Health Act 1997. Families should also let the school know.

If your child is not well, then they should not attend school.

Communication With Families

This term there will be an opportunity to meet with

your child/ren's class teacher (formerly Parent-Teacher Interviews) during the week of Monday 6th June to Friday 10th June in the school hall, or over the phone. Early next week a letter will go home about how to book an appointment time online.





2. Enter your school access key: as per the flyer below
3. Enter your personal email address.
4. If you are ordering student photos, click on the "student" button.
5. Enter your child's name correctly. You do not need to nominate your child's class. Leave the "folder" field blank.
6. Enter your full name and contact details on the "Your Details" page.
7. Choose your products and proceed to view the cart.
8. To order for other children press "add another student" and follow steps 3-7 again. When ordering for family photos, press the "family" button on the first page, and follow the above steps.
9. To complete your purchase, view your cart and add your payment details and process.
10. Once processed you will receive a confirmation of your order to your nominated email address.
