Learning Assets

When we are engaging our students in inquiring how they learn, we are also providing them with the skills that they will be able to use in all facets of life. These are called Learning Assets, and they can be used across the curriculum, in school, and beyond. We have named up five learning assets that we will be focusing on with the students. So far, we have discussed and explored three of them – being a Self-Manager, Thinker and Collaborator. This term we will be discussing and exploring the remaining two learning assets – 'I am a Researcher' and 'I am a Communicator'.

A **Researcher** is courageous, resourceful and critical. Being a researcher means:

- I ask relevant questions.
- I can locate and use a wide range of sources and techniques to investigate problems, issues and questions.
- I think critically about the information I gather, and I acknowledge my source.
- I am brave to have a go and improve my learning.

A **Communicator** is responsive, respectful and confident. Being a communicator means:

- I am approachable and listen thoughtfully to others.
- I willingly share my thinking and understanding.
- I can communicate ideas confidently in different ways and for different purposes.

To help embed these learning assets, please discuss the five learning assets with your students and ask them how they have used them throughout the day.


